What is the POLKA DOT TROT?

The Polka Dot Trot is the Cancer Care Foundation's signature event designed to support and uniquely connect those affected by all forms of cancer.

It is a 5km walk to raise funds in support of cancer care right here at home. With the Polka Dot Trot, you can fundraise as a team or individually and choose to walk in the colour of the cancer that matters to you the most.

This year's event is back again at Paradise Park and we will walk around scenic Octagon Pond. However if you're not in the St. John's metro area, a walk in your hometown is always an option!

What do I have to do?

1. ARE YOU A TEAM PLAYER?

You can join the Polka Dot Trot as an individual or as a team. If you are a team player, grab as many members as you like, come up with an awesome name and raise funds for all cancers. Registering a team is excellent for team building within a corporate organization and family looking to strengthen their bond or a unified group of friends.

2. REGISTER

Visit **www.polkadottrot.ca** and click on the register button. Once you are in there, you have an option to join as an individual or join a team and follow the prompts. The registration fee is \$20 for individuals or team members.

What is my next step?

Once you have registered, you can invite friends to join you and get started on your fundraising.

You have an option to create your own personal story on your fundraising page and explain to your supporters why you are walking. It is a unique way to tell your story and connection to cancer while raising money for Cancer care right here at home.

How do I fundraise?

Visit **www.polkadottrot.ca** and using your login information you can access your fundraising page. Anyone who wishes to support you and donate to such a wonderful cause can do this online through your personal event page. You can also share your personal page to your social media outlets like Facebook and Instagram. Other fun ways to fundraise is to host a bake sale, a bottle drive or an office fundraising challenge! Please refrain from holding raffles and 50/50 draws, as these require lottery license. Also, donations in return for something (a product or experience) are not eligible for a tax receipt.



What is corporate matching?

Many companies offer a Corporate Matching Gifts program – matching donations made by employees to a charity. This is a great opportunity to boost your team fundraising efforts.

- Your Company Name
- Amount of the donation anticipated from your company's Matching Gift Program

What if someone is late donating?

Don't worry! The Polka Dot Trot website will be accepting online donations for a full week after the event up until an including October 22, 2023.
